1. Read again David's prayer in 1 Chronicles 29:10-22. How is David's prayer related to his vision for the future? Why does he want to build a Temple for God?
2. Which of the ten characteristics of God grabbed you the most?
3. What is the common thread we see in v. 6, 9 and 17? But what in 18 informs our understanding of why the people gave?
4. What does David say is the source of all our giving? What image does he use to describe this truth in v. 14?
5. Think about v. 17. What does David say motivated his own giving to the work of the Lord?
6. What does David imply our fitting response is to the greatness of God?

1. What was new and most challenging in the text/message this week and why?

4. Describe the way the people gave to the work of the Lord in David's day. (There are at least 4 ways described in the text, which I mentioned at the banquet! ) Which of these characteristics is most challenging in your own giving?
5. How do you think the Building on the Legacy Capital Campaign came together? If you went to the banquet, did you feel like the evening was marked by a spirit of celebration?
