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**PREPARING to be with One Another**

Use a separate sheet of paper or notebook to work through these questions in advance of your Growth Group gathering. The more people come prepared, the richer and deeper and more real our discussions will be with one another.

**CONNECTING with One Another**

Open your time by checking in with one another to see how you're doing and how one another's week was.

**EXPLORING God's Word with One Another**

*Remember, we're giving you more than you can really discuss here. Pick a few questions that will take you back into the content of the passage and message.*

1. Read Luke 9:10-17. What is the situation described? How did the situation arise? What was the subject of Jesus' teaching? Why did the disciples come to Him?
2. What is the problem in the text and how is it solved? Who solves it and how?
3. Is Jesus' ministry about the meeting of spiritual needs or physical needs or a combination of both? How does Luke 4:17-19 shed light on this question and frame the ministry of Jesus?
4. In the text, who are "the Neglected"? Who are "the Nobodies"? Who are "the Needy"?

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**APPLYING God's Word with One Another**

1. Who are the neglected, the nobodies and the needy in our world today?
2. Are we called to meet spiritual needs, physical needs or a combination of both?
3. How does the text provide us a paradigm for how God works and what are the implications for our lives?
4. Given all the demands of your own personal life, how are you making room and time to let God use you to meet the needs of others around you and the needs of the needy around the world? If you're not, what changes might you make in your life to make room for God to use you?
5. How do we avoid becoming overwhelmed by the enormous personal and global needs all around us?

**PRAYING for One Another**

1. Quickly share personal requests.
2. Use the truth of the message as a "springboard" to pray for your personal growth, your Growth Group and the growth of our life at GraceSLO.
